What should I have done prior to attending a registration day?

Admission File

In order to enroll in classes on a registration day, students need to be accepted for admission. This means a student must have applied online and turned in all required admission paperwork.

Campus Connection

Students should have claimed their campus connection account prior to registration. If you have not done so, please [click here](#).

What should I expect at a new student registration day?

Check-in

Students will be required to check-in upon arrival. This is to ensure the student is on the advising schedule and is ready to meet with an advisor. Students still missing paperwork will be sent to speak with an Enrollment Services representative.

Advising

Students will meet with an academic advisor. Your program of study will determine which academic advisor you will be assigned. An advisor assists you in creating a class schedule for the upcoming semester.

Enrollment

Once a student has been successfully advised, they will be directed to the enrollment room. A college representative will walk you through the enrollment process in your campus connection account. We will also assist you in setting up your WSC student email if you have not done so.

Student ID Card

Students will receive their student ID after they have officially enrolled. Your picture will be taken.

Financial Aid

After the enrollment process, students may be directed to a Financial Aid representative. Students will be walked through a checklist of what is needed for their financial aid. This will include anything from FAFSA (loans and grants), scholarships, work study, estimated cost of attendance, etc.

Housing

A housing representative will be available for students that may have housing questions or need assistance with filling out our housing application. Please be sure to bring a credit/debit card if you would like to take care of the fees associated with the housing application.

What if I am unable to attend a registration day?

If you are unable to attend a registration day, you can schedule an appointment with your assigned advisor. To view your advisor, log in to your [campus connection](#) account. Click on the Academic Progress tile. Select Advisors and Advising Notes to view your advisor. You can be advised over the phone, email or in person.
