Risk and Action Levels

Level 1 | Normal Operations

Normal operations at capacity resume under heightened hygiene, cleaning, and social distancing standards. Face covering is required in common areas and classrooms where social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible.

Level 2 | Low Risk

Most operations continue at capacity. Athletics, Bookstore, Dining, and Student Life activities are conducted with contact restrictions. Community events and gatherings held on campus are scheduled with contact restrictions. Face covering is required in common areas and classrooms where social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible.

Level 3 | Moderate Risk

All Athletic, Student Life, Community, and Campus events are limited to 75% of capacity with contact restrictions. Seating in the Teton Grill is limited to 75% of capacity, with “grab and go” meals available. Temperature screening for individuals in high-risk environments is available, as well as regular self-assessment based on the CDC COVID-19 symptom checklist.

Individuals in high risk environments are provided with surveillance testing information during the current semester. Face covering is required in common areas and classrooms where social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible.

Level 4 | High Risk

All Athletic, Student Life, Community, and Campus events are limited to 25% of capacity with contact restrictions. Meals served in the Teton Grill are packaged for pick-up, no on-site dining is available. The WSC Bookstore is open by appointment only. Instructors accelerate planning for transition to an online environment. Face covering is required in common areas and classrooms where social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible.

Level 5 | Critical Risk

All Level 4 stipulations remain in force. Athletic, Student Life, Community, and Campus events are cancelled or transitioned to an on-line modality if possible. Students transition out of campus housing as soon as is practical. Instruction moves to an online format with 1-1 labs in the CTE areas. Only essential employees work on campus. Face covering is required in common areas and classrooms where social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible.
