Our school must review the requested information, under the financial aid program rules 34 CFR, Part 668 – Subpart E.

All sections must be completed for processing. Financial aid cannot be accepted or disbursed until verification is complete.

- The Verification process can take one to two weeks. We suggest that you submit all information by one of the methods listed on the last page WITHIN 2 WEEKS.
- DO NOT make any changes to the FAFSA while in the Verification process.
- If any of the sections of this worksheet are left blank or any WET signatures are missing, this worksheet will be returned
 for completion, thereby delaying the processing of your financial aid.
