## 2024-2025 SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Academic Year 2024-2025 Williams County Graduate, Regional County Graduate, and Academic Achievement Award (WRA) Scholarships will cover **tuition** and **fees** for eligible high school graduates and GEDs earned within the qualifying counties identified below. Failure to meet any of the terms or conditions below will result in ineligibility and/or loss of this scholarship.

### ELIGIBILITY AND PRIORITY DEADLINES

- A graduate of an accredited high school identified below.
- GED earned in a county identified below by students who have not previously earned a high school diploma or GED.
- Homeschool must be registered with the appropriate school district superintendent's office in the applicable county.
- Verification of graduation will be required in the form of an official transcript or GED diploma.
  - *(If you have at least 24 transfer credits from another college, please contact the Financial Aid office and submit your High School Transcript or GED Diploma to Financial Aid).*
- Submitted Academic Year 2024-2025 WSC Application for Admission. (<https://willistonstate.edu/apply>)
- Graduates must enroll as degree-seeking students for Academic Year 2024-2025
- Official date of eligibility will be determined by the date of application for admission.
- **This Scholarship will cover tuition and fees after ND State Grants and then WSC Internal Scholarships have been applied first to student accounts.**
  - A completed and verified FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is recommended (required for 2025-2026 school year); <https://studentaid.gov/>
  - A completed WSC Internal AwardSpring Scholarship application is recommended (required for 2025-2026 school year); <https://willistonstate.awardspring.com/>

### REQUIREMENTS

- Enrolled as a part-time (1 to 8 credit hours) WSC student consecutively, excluding summer.
- Enrolled as a full-time (12 to 16 credit hours); for **ALL** programs. WSC student for up to four consecutive semesters, i.e., *Fall 2024 to Spring 2026*, excluding summer.
- Maintain good academic standing defined as a **2.0 term GPA** or higher at the end of the semester.
- Only attended on-campus/online courses will be paid for by the scholarship. **Any dropped course(s) for a no-show and charged 25% will be the student's responsibility to pay.**
- 2025-2026 FAFSA & 2025-2026 WSC Internal AwardSpring Scholarship Application required; OPENS OCT. 1, 2025.

### MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship recipients must remain compliant with the listed requirements to maintain scholarship eligibility.

### FOUNDATION NOTES

- The WSC Foundation reserves the right to revoke scholarships if the recipient(s) fail to satisfy requirements.
- Williams County Graduate, Regional County Graduate, and Academic Achievement Award Scholarships are only valid for the actual amount of tuition and fees charged (does not include no-show charges) to a student account. Scholarships are non-refundable and have no cash value.
- If students are in the LPN or ADN Nursing program or in their last semester to graduate they do not need to be full-time.
- Diesel and Welding Students are allowed to keep their Tool scholarships.
- Nursing and Massage Therapy Students are allowed to keep the Pergande Scholarship.
- This scholarship is not intended for students with bachelor's degrees.
- **The scholarships will continue as long as funds are available.**
