

Sadie and Alexander and Dr. John A. Harchanko Memorial Scholarship – Terms and Conditions

- a) No child of a professional person is eligible for this scholarship.
- b) The individuals of first choice must be enrolled members of the Fort Peck Reservation, to include the communities of Poplar and Wolf Point, Montana. If no qualified individual is available that year, Williston State College may next look to Trenton, North Dakota High School for an enrolled member of the Turtle Mountain Indian Reservation. No graduate of Williston High School shall be eligible. If no qualified student is yet found, the scholarship shall next be granted to any Native American student, looking first to North Dakota, and then to Montana.
- c) The individuals shall be awarded on the basis of the most need, giving priority to orphans and members of families whose income is below the poverty line. The recipient shall be a good citizen and have demonstrated an ability to succeed in college, and shall include older-than-average students otherwise qualified.
- d) Students seeking scholarship assistance shall comply with all Williston State College application policies as they are established from time to time. In addition, the applicants shall submit two written recommendations from adults not related to the applicant, who have known the applicant for more than three years, which attest to the applicant's worthiness for the scholarship assistance. The selection of scholarship recipients shall remain within the sole discretion of Williston State College, seeking input from teachers of the respective schools from which students are applicants.
- e) The scholarship defined above shall be available for the first year at Williston State College, and shall include tuition, books, lab fees, room and board and tutorial aid.
- f) Once granted, provided the student maintains a C grade average, and meets the other criteria established, the scholarship shall be maintained at Williston State College for up to a two-year period. No courses sponsored by the University of North Dakota will be allowed, including flying, or any other University of North Dakota on-line courses. The courses from any other university are allowable, when received by the student at Williston State College.
- g) I direct that the scholarships be awarded annually as the Sadie and Alexander and John A. Harchanko Memorial Scholarship and shall be presented at a high school ceremony at the school attended by the recipient, if applicable. The award must be announced in the Poplar, Wolf Point, Minot, and Williston papers, with pictures. In the event payment is necessary for the announcement or pictures, publicity payments shall be provided out of the funds. The total amount of yearly interest and principal should be acknowledged under the proper giving club in the schools' alumni magazine and other appropriate places consistent with other giving club acknowledgements.
- h) Williston State College shall furnish to my probate attorney, his or her successor, and my accountant, Rick Darvis, his or her successor, a balance sheet annually setting forth the beginning and ending balance, the type of investments, and their terms and location, what activity took place in the scholarships, the names of the recipients and the basis of their qualifications, and photocopies of publicity announcements. The fees for the such review by my probate attorney shall be paid by the Williston State College from the scholarship fund.
