The Fall 2021 Regional County Scholarship will cover **tuition** and **fees** up to 16 credit hours per semester for four consecutive semesters (excluding summer) for eligible 2021 high school graduates and GEDs earned within the regional counties identified below. Failure to meet any of the terms or conditions below will result in ineligibility for and/or loss of this scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY AND PRIORITY DEADLINES

- A 2021 graduate of an accredited high school identified below
- A 2021 GED completed in a county identified below
- Verification of graduation will be required in the form of an official transcript or GED diploma
- Submitted Fall 2021 WSC Application for Admission submitted to WSC by May 1, 2021 – www.willistonstate.edu/apply
- A **completed and verified** FAFSA application by August 2, 2021 despite appeal processes. **Starting Spring 2022 Federal Grants will be awarded after the scholarship is applied to all tuition and fees.**
- Graduates must enroll as degree-seeking students starting Fall 2021
- Official date of eligibility will be determined by the date of application for admission and completed FAFSA, whichever is later

REQUIREMENTS

- Enrolled as a full-time WSC student starting Fall 2021 (scholarship funds 12 to 16 credit hours per semester)
- Enrolled for up to four consecutive semesters (*Fall 2021 to Spring 2023*), excluding summer
- Maintain good academic standing defined as a 2.0 term GPA or higher at end of semester
- A minimum of one on-campus course completed during Fall 2021. **Starting Spring 2022 you no longer need to take one on-campus course.**
- A **completed and verified** FAFSA each academic year

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship recipients must remain compliant with the listed requirements to maintain scholarship eligibility.
