## COURSE KEY DISCRIPTION

### ONLINE CLASS

• Online classes are NOT self paced. They are set up similar to on campus classes with specific assignment due dates and quiz times. Online courses will show up in the My Courses tab in Blackboard once classes officially begin.




### IVN CLASS

• Interactive Video Network (IVN) classes meet in a face to face classroom style setting on the days and times listed on the course schedule via the use of technology. IVN classes are not self-paced and students are expected to attend class at specific assigned times and locations. IVN classes utilize technology such as mics, cameras and computer/television screens to allow students and faculty from multiple locations to meet in a virtual format. Classes may be held in a physical classroom or on individual computers. Location of IVN classes vary by course and are listed on the course schedule.

### HYBRID/BLENDED

• Hybrid/Blended courses combine face to face instruction with online instruction in various ways. Students should be available on the days and times listed for the course, though the class may meet in the classroom or online-live, while also allowing for release time to work online in lieu of a scheduled meeting. The instructor will provide a detailed description to students during the first week of class.
